Icebreaker

Classes

Conversation exercises will include language games and problem-based learning in real situations. Pronunciation exercises will take many forms.

We will teach you many practical things such as how to introduce yourself in Icelandic, how to ask for directions, how to welcome your guests etc.

Breakfast

While you are having breakfast in the mornings the teaching will start. We will teach you some vocabulary about food, the politeness manners in Iceland etc.

Lunch

When you are having lunch we will keep on teaching – a little differently than in the classes.

Afternoon coffee

There is no teaching during afternoon coffee. Then you can just relax and enjoy drinking good coffee or tea and eating some good cake – and maybe you can try to speak some Icelandic to the other participants.

Dinner and more on Saturday evening

While participants dine together the teaching will continue; Icelandic food will be on the tables and on Saturday evening everybody will have a lots of fun singing Icelandic folk songs with Icelandic guitar players and more.
