Icebreaker

Watch a film with a teacher

Your instructor briefly introduces the film. Films will be in Icelandic (with English subtitle). After the film there is time for discussion.

Final party and dinner

On the Friday evening all the participants will dine together and have a lot of fun before they go in separate ways.

Students staying in Ísafjörður can enjoy discovering the town's quaint bakeries, wandering the streets, and exploring the coastline. In Ísafjörður you can go swimming, golfing and much more. In the evenings students can go out and have something to eat or drink on several different places.
