Serious stuff, in the morning: Mon-Fri, 09-12

Basics of grammar and vocabulary taught through lectures and exercises. Training in reading and writing skills up to CEFR level A1.

Erasmus and Nordplus students who are staying at Núpur boarding school will have morning lessons there and will be divided into different groups and levels. Participants staying in Ísafjörður will form a separate group in the mornings. The groups will mix during afternoons and weekends.

Small-group work, in the afternoon: Mon-Fri, 14-16 or 16-18

Groups ABCD, 14-16: Conversation, pronunciation, language games, problem-based learning.
Groups EFGH, 16-18: Conversation, pronunciation, language games, problem-based learning.

Individual work, in the afternoon: Mon-Fri, 14-16 or 16-18

Either before or after the small-group period, students will have time in Ísafjörður for their own individual work. Visit the library, or use the University Centre's facilities (including computers with free Internet access and wireless network) to prepare to just to answer your e-mail.

Choir practice

Practice your Icelandic pronunciation by singing under the guidance of a professional choral director.

Listen to a lecture in simple Icelandic

Each week, we offer a lecture in simple Icelandic. You will be surprised how much you already understand!

Mondays: watch a film with your teacher

Your instructor briefly introduces the film in simple Icelandic and goes over key vocabulary. Films will be in Icelandic (some have English subtitles). After the film there is time for discussion.

Wednesday excursions

Every Wednesday afternoon we organize an excursion in the near vicinity of Ísafjörður. Each excursion focuses on a particular topic connected to the course. The guide will speak simple Icelandic. These excursions, including the guide and all entrances, are included in the course fee.

Friday evenings in Ísafjörður

We provide a late bus from Ísafjörður to Núpur on Friday evenings, free of charge, to accommodate special evening events. (Note that on other days, late buses can be organized on request for a reasonable fee.)

Sunday trips

Longer day trips are organized each Sunday. These trips are not included in the course fee and have to be prepaid at least one week in advance. A minimum number of participants is required for each trip. Further information on day trips will be presented during the first days of the course.

Gísla Saga theme week

During week II Gísla Saga will be our special theme. On Thursday there will be an introduction to the famous saga in simple Icelandic, and a visit to one of the settings of the saga, where you will have to use your Icelandic. On Friday we will watch an acclaimed stage version of Gísla Saga, performed as a one-man production by Elfar Logi Hannesson, the only actor in all the West Fjords. In keeping with the theme, the Sunday day trip will visit sites connected to Gísla Saga in Geirþjófsfjörður.
