### Classes in the morning

Basics of grammar and vocabulary taught through lectures and exercises. Training in reading and writing skills up to CEFR level **A1**.

During this ultra-short course, the focus will be on pronunciation and a basic understanding of the language. But, after this course participants will be able to pronounce correctly the names of all Icelandic volcanoes, irrespective of which will erupt next.

### Short courses in the afternoon

In the afternoons you will have a variety of short courses, with partly unusual teaching methods. You will learn Icelandic through dancing, acting and playing. The pronunciation class is taught in small groups for 10-15 minutes each and the vocabulary class is individual learning with a computer programme under your teacher's supervision. Conversation exercises for small groups, language games, problem-based learning, but here you will also find lectures in easy Icelandic (you will be surprised how much you already understand!). Teachers are Actors and professional dance teachers and teachers with long experience.

### Watch a film with your teacher

Your instructor briefly introduces the film in simple Icelandic and goes over key vocabulary. Films will be in Icelandic (some have English subtitles). After the film there is time for discussion.

Most of the teaching, as well as the films will be at the University Centre of the Westfjords.

Some classes in the afternoon might be in other places.
