### Bekkjarkennsla að morgni - Classes in the morning

Basics of grammar and vocabulary taught through lectures and exercises. Training in reading and writing skills up to CEFR level **A1**.  
Teacher: Ólöf Bergmannsdóttir, B.A. in Icelandic with many years of experience in teaching Icelandic to immigrants.

### Pronunciation Sessions

You will have a two 20 minute private sessions with two different teachers where you focus on pronunciation. Teacher Peter Weiss will focus on theoretical aspects of pronunciation while teacher Ólöf Bergmannsdóttir will go deeper into the course material that you are studying.

### Málfræðisurningar - Grammar Questions

Here you can come and ask a teacher about grammar, whether you want to know more than what the morning lessons give you, or if you do not understand the grammar that is taught in the morning lesson.

### Búðarall – Shopping rally

Students will be divided into small groups and sent on a mission in downtown Ísafjörður. At the first stop, they will receive a map and instructions on where to go. At each stop, the students have a task they will have to complete, e.g. find a particular person in the store and ask a question or find out how much a particular item costs. Students will also have to mark the places on the map. The answers to all the questions will be submitted to the course leader when the last task has been completed.

### Fyrsta hjálp – First aid

In this course students will learn basic vocabulary that has to do with first aid, body parts, injuries and other relevant vocabulary. Students will learn about the importance of first aid and when it is necessary to call 112 (the Icelandic emergency number). They will also learn basic skills to respond to emergencies, accidents, illnesses, and other similar events, until specialized help arrives. Students will also get training in CPR, respiratory and how to use a defibrillator for CPR.

### Nýyrðasmíði – Creating new words

To form new words, to be creative when it comes to making new words, is said to be a kind of national sport in Iceland. There are strikingly few loan words in Icelandic, a fact that characterises the language. The new words have not been forced into place by national authorities, but by numerous committees in the respective fields and private persons.

This elective course introduces to typical elements of word-formation and then the class forms such a committee to be creative and form new words. You will be astonished how much you can say, when having the right elements at hand.
