Classes in the morning: Mon-Fri, 09-12

Basics of grammar and vocabulary taught through lectures and exercises. Training in reading and writing skills up to CEFR level A1/A2. Please prepare for the course through IcelandicOnline (cf. prerequisites: https://www.uw.is/beginners_a1-a2/apply_beginners/).

Speak Up! Talaðu!

In this course students will learn how to pronounce sounds essential to pronunciation of Icelandic. Improvisations, sing-along and oral exercises will be done to practice voice control and pronunciation. Students will work with different texts.

Special courses in the afternoon

The afternoon courses focus on exercises in the society and culture. The afternoon courses consist of pronunciation and conversation exercises, language games, problem-based learning, but here you will also find lectures in easy Icelandic (you will be surprised how much you already understand!). Further information about these classes can be found in the afternoon classes brochure.

Grammar Questions

Here you can come and ask a teacher about grammar, whether you want to know more than what the morning lessons give you, or if you do not understand the grammar that is taught in the morning lesson.

Choir

You can't sing? That's no problem. This choir won't teach you singing but pronouncing. So, forget about the singing and forget about the language, simply imitate your professional choral director.

BEGINNERS A1-A2 ÍSAFJÖRÐUR

Svanurinn – Movie with introduction by director Ása Helga Hjörleifsdóttir

Director Ása Helga Hjörleifsdóttir will visit us and screen her film Svanurinn (The Swan, 2017), adapted from the novel by Guðbergur Bergsson.

Watch a film with your teacher

Your instructor briefly introduces the film in simple Icelandic and goes through key vocabulary. Films will be in Icelandic (with English subtitles). After the film there is time for discussion.

ActAlone theatre festival in Suðureyri

Annually in August, there is the ActAlone theatre festival in Suðureyri (25 km from Ísafjörður) with exclusively one-man's plays. Find more information on www.actalone.net. There will be a bus-shuttle organised by ActAlone between Suðureyri and Ísafjörður.

Gísla Saga theatre and visit to the sites of the saga in Haukadal

Haukadalur, where Gísli lived before he was outlawed, is just 60 km driving from Ísafjörður. As Gísla Saga is one of the most famous Icelandic sagas, every child in school knows it and so will you after this course.

During the last week, there will be an introduction to the famous saga in simple Icelandic as well as a filmed version, and a visit to the settings of the saga in Haukadal, where you will have to use your Icelandic. To get you onto the topic, we will watch an acclaimed stage version of Gísla Saga, performed as a one-man production by Elfar Logi Hannesson, the only actor in all the West Fjords. The Gísla Saga programme is included in the course fee.

IceBreaker

We start the course with an IceBreaker during the first evening, Monday, 30.07.2018, 21:00, where we introduce you to the programme and you learn to know each other. There will be light refreshments available.

IceCream

In the end of the course you have well-deserved that we make a bow for you. You will receive your certificates – and perhaps an ice cream.

Most of the teaching, as well as the films will take place at the University Centre of the Westfjords. The IceBreaker is on Monday evening, 21:00, at UWestfjords.

Saturday/Sunday: Free time for own activities

From Ísafjörður, there are daily boat trips to Hornstrandir nature reserve as well as to the island Vigur, "the pearl in the fjord". There are numerous hiking paths and recreational options like kayaking. Why not rent a bike and get you around by your own?
